Last Man Standing	Danger of falling	This mechanical ride requires rider to be struck with an inflated rotating beam. Only one person allowed on each station. Users must be able to mount the ride unaided and meet the minimum height required of 1.2mtrs (approx. 4 feet)	4	2	1	Crowd control may be required by an additional assistant supervisor
Last Man Standing	Danger of being struck by the ride	A responsible, trained person must operate ride at all times. Keyed "OFF" isolation switch used when ride unattended. Spectators must not freely bounce on the inflatable bed.	5	1	1	None
Last Man Standing	Overloading	Responsible person to supervise at all times. Only one person per station, 8 stations total. Maximum weight of user, 13 stones / 82kgs	2	2	1	None
Last Man Standing	Adverse weather	Equipment not to be used in high winds over 24mph (includes gusts) and during heavy rain. Marquee provided for light rain.	2	2	1	Quarantine unit from use or deflate until conditions improve
Last Man Standing	Injury from hard surfaces	Use on a grassed area using industry standard stakes. Use approved thunder bolts on hard standing and use matting. Use sand bags indoors and use matting	1	1	1	None
Last Man Standing	Injury from poor supervision	Responsible person to supervise and operate ride at all times. Do not use without adequate qualified supervision present	1	2	2	If event has a large attendance more supervisors should be supplied to assist
Last Man Standing	Tripping over anchor points / auxiliary equipment	Anchor points installed to manufactures guidance. Additional equipment stored away. Power cables to be positioned /covered appropriately	1	1	2	None
Last Man Standing	Injury through incorrect positioning	Equipment installed correctly in a safe position. Never attempt to reposition the unit	-	-	-	None
Last Man Standing	Choking	No foods / chewing gum / drinks allowed on the equipment	1	2	1	None
Last Man Standing	Third party injury	Remove shoes, eye glasses, jewellery, badges and lanyards. All drinking containers to be positioned away from play areas	2	2	2	None
Last Man Standing	Historical injury	No user should have a history of back or neck problems, have heart issues, is pregnant, is under the influence of drugs /drink or feeling unwell	1	2	1	None
Last Man Standing	Inflation with combustion engine/gennie	No Smoking. Spare fuel to be located in a locked store. Fencing installed around plant area.	1	2	1	None
Last Man Standing	Emergency	In the event of a serious injury do not move the individual and call First Aid / dial 999	1	2	1	None
